

# MSC Online Parent Moodle Access

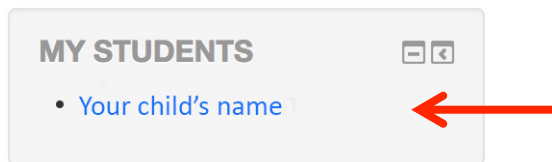
Parents are encouraged to actively participate in their child's online experience. If you would like to monitor your child's progress and online activity, you can request access by contacting us at [msconline@nesc.k12.mn.us](mailto:msconline@nesc.k12.mn.us). Once your account is set up, follow the steps below.

1. Go to <http://www.msconline.us> to access our Moodle course site. The login button is in the top right hand corner of the page.

- Your username will be your email address.
- Your temporary password will be: *changeme*

After you login for the first time, you will be required to change your password, and log back in using this new password. Remember to write down you new password.

2. Once logged in, you will see a "My Students" block on the left side of the page. The names of your child should be displayed.



3. Click on your child's name. It will bring up their profile.

4. Next to Course profile, **click on the specific course** you would like to view.

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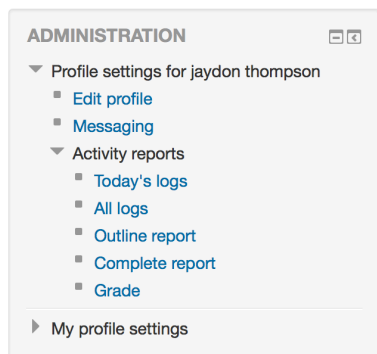
